

TIINA MYLLÄRINEN: SQUARCIO (2011)

Squarcio on Myllärisen musiikille tyypillistä räjähtävää energiota sisältävä teos, joka tuntuu kasvavan alituisseensa limittyvien crescendojen myötä. Teoksen voi jakaa kahteen osaan: kasvattava ensimmäinen osa, joka johtaa toiseen, tiheämpää ja kerroksellisempää muusikkia sisältävään osaan, joka aina välillä yllättää leikkautuu omaan hälyjen täyttämään varjoonsa. Musiikin katkaisevat voimakkaat polyrytmiset ryöpsähdykset sekä tihenevät crescendot johtavat teoksen loppuun, mutta juuri ennen viimeistä nousua odottaa vielä yksi yllätys.

Squarcio has the explosive energy typical of Myllärinен's music and grows in overlapping crescendos. It may be divided into two parts, the expansive first leading to a denser, more layered second. The music is marked off by strong, polyrhythmic eruptions and ever-denser crescendos that carry the piece to its close. There is, however, one more surprise in store just before the final build-up.
