PERFORMANCE INSTRUCTIONS

The accidentals refer only to the notes they immediately precede. The occasional natural signs are safeguards only.

Flute:

All the multiphonics in the piece are produced by altering the blowing pressure.

- ⊕ = added pressure
- ⊖ = diminished pressure
- Ⓝ → ⊖ = normal pressure, which is gradually diminished, until the tone breaks up into a multiphonic.

In one case, the desired pitches of the multiphonic sound are given in brackets.

Cello:

- ♯ = left hand pizzicato
