Positions:

blue colour represents A string



(XXII. position) usually the thumb is on the third octave of the open string

orange colour represents D string



(XV. position) usually the thumb is on the second octave of the open string

green colour represents G string



(XII. position) usually the thumb is on the octave and a fifth of the open string

red colour represents C string



(VIII. position) usually the thumb is on the first octave of the open string

(IV. position) fourth position + harmonic one octave higher above the open string (3rd finger)
