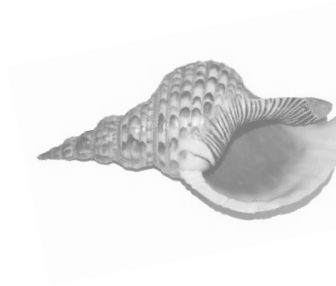


LARA POE

*Triton* for solo trumpet  
(2019)



Triton alludes to multiple things, mainly the sea god Triton, and the triton shell. According to Greek mythology, the sea god Triton was half-fish and half human and would blow on a conch shell to either calm the sea or raise waves. The Triton shell is named after this sea god.

My piece is mainly constructed of two types of material. The first, which appears at the beginning of the piece, opens with a trumpet call that rises by a fourth, and this is followed by a more meandering line. The second type of material is more undulating in nature and appears after a tempo change. There is also a link between this second material, and the meandering line at the end of the first phrase.

Triton viittaa sekä kreikkalaiseen jumalaan nimeltä Triton että triton-nimiseen simpukkaan. Kreikkalaisen mytologian mukaan Triton-jumala oli puoliksi kala, puoliksi ihminen ja pystyi hallitsemaan merta puhaltamalla simpukasta tehtyyn trumpettiin. Charonia tritonis -simpukka on nimetty tämän jumalan mukaan.

Teos koostuu lähinnä kahdenlaisesta materiaalista. Ensimmäinen materiaalityyppi esiintyy kappaleen alussa. Kappale aukeaa fanfaarimaisella eleellä, joka nousee kvartin, ja tätä elettä seuraa harhaileva sävelkulku. Toinen,aaltoilevampi materiaalityyppi tulee esille tempomuutoksen jälkeen. Se myös linkittyy ensimmäisen materiaalin harhailevaan sävelkulkuun.
